- Join us at the Midwest's premier road course, Hallett Motor Racing Circuit. Openings will be filled as they are received.
- Because of the changes in track rental costs and track fee structures, we regret that we must impose a track fee on instructors. The fee is \$125 prior to August 1st. After August 1st, 2010 – the rate changes to \$149.
- The fee entitles each instructor to drive on track during the instructor run group sessions on Saturday and Sunday, and all day during the open track periods on Friday. Please provide your credit card information or enclose a check payable to "Kansas City BMW Club"
- Helmets meeting Snell Foundation standards M2000, SA2000 or newer are required.
- Please go to our web site at <http://www.kcbmwclub.com> to download a detailed information packet including track information, lodging options, and the event manual. Our driving school curriculum is also available for you at that site. If you have problems downloading a document, please e-mail webmaster@kcbmwclub.com.
- All makes and models of cars are welcome, provided they pass a pre-event safety inspection and a trackside safety check. (Convertibles must have full roll bars, at least two five-point harnesses and must be approved in advance on a case-by-case basis.)

- If you are sharing a car with another instructor or with a student, each driver must fill out separate registration forms. No more than two drivers per car. Shared cars may be required to run back-to-back track sessions.
- The use of helmet intercoms is strongly encouraged. It's better for the student, and it makes your work a lot easier.
- All participants and guests are required to sign an insurance company form waiving their rights to sue. A copy of the waiver is in the information packet. If you would like to read a copy prior to submitting, this application, you may request one by contacting the Driving School Registrar. Minor children (under 18) may not be admitted without a minor release waiver signed by both parents in advance (or sole custodian with proof of custody). Please call in advance for waiver release forms if you will be bringing minor children to the facility.
- Please contact us if you have any questions. The quality of our school depends on the quality of our instructors, and we want to make this a rewarding experience for you and every participant.
- Cancellations: NO refunds will be given. We will give you a full credit for a future Driving School.
