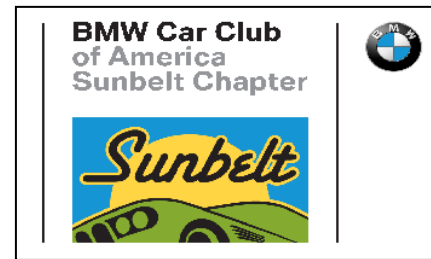

Be a part of a new and unique event! The Kansas City BMW Club, and the Sunbelt BMW Club are joining forces to present the 4<sup>th</sup> Annual Regional High-Performance Driver's Education school titled, "No Excuses 4."

The school takes place September 9<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup>, 2011 at Hallett Motor Racing Circuit, just west of Tulsa, OK. Hallett has over 80 feet of elevation change and is considered technically difficult. It has wide, grassy run-off areas and zero concrete or Armco barriers! It is a perfect learning track and provides a challenge for more experienced students. The purpose of the event is to learn high performance driving techniques in a safe, controlled environment. Instructors will be provided for all students. Instructors, and Advanced Students with the Event master's approval, will be given the opportunity to improve their skills on Friday, September 9<sup>th</sup> with Advanced Student and Instructor training/orientation.

# Kansas City/Sunbelt BMW Club Driving School at Hallett Motor Racing Circuit

## September 9, 10, and 11 2011

- Registration is now open. Openings will be filled as they are received, by postmark date.
- Cost for the school is \$289. This is a **two-day school**; there are no one-day registrations. All checks are deposited upon receipt. Do not send cash.
- All drivers must be at least 18 years of age and possess a full, valid, non-suspended, and current state driver's license. No previous experience necessary. We will have Beginner, Novice, Intermediate, and Advanced run groups. Run groups are scheduled to receive multiple track sessions per day.
- All makes and models of cars are welcome, provided they pass a pre-event safety inspection and a trackside safety check. (Convertibles must have full roll bars, at least two five-point harnesses and must be approved in advance on a case-by-case basis.) All student cars must be licensed, insured, street-legal, and muffled. SUV's may not participate in this Event.
- You must bring a Snell Foundation-rated M2000 or SA2000 (or newer) helmet. Students who do not have an approved helmet, or whose cars do not pass a trackside safety check will not be allowed on the track and no refunds will be made. Loaner helmets are not available.
- Registrants receive an information packet, classroom instruction, and on-track instruction.
- You can pay either by mail with a check or online with check or credit card. Checks must be payable to "Kansas City BMW Club." You must download the detailed information packet that includes track information, lodging options, event manual, and technical inspection forms. Novices must also download the high-performance driving manual. The download is available at [www.kcbmwclub.com](http://www.kcbmwclub.com). If you have trouble downloading a document, e-mail [webmaster@kcbmwclub.com](mailto:webmaster@kcbmwclub.com) for assistance.
- Be sure to include your e-mail address so that we can confirm your registration and notify you of any additional information prior to the school.
- Cancellations: NO refunds will be given. We will give you a full credit for a future Driving School.
- Each driver must fill out separate registration forms even if sharing a car. No more than two drivers per car. Shared cars *may* be required to run back-to-back track sessions.
- All participants and guests are required to sign an insurance company form waiving their rights to sue. A copy of the waiver is in the information packet. If you would like to read a copy prior to submitting this application, you may request one by contacting the Driving School Registrar.
